



SAFE USE OF OUR LIMOUSINES

We are pleased to be able to bring our limousines back into use with the addition of specially designed Perspex screens, which have been developed by Wilcox Coachbuilders who build the vehicles. These screens separate the front two seats of the vehicle from the passenger area for the safety of both parties.

Between uses, the limousines are thoroughly sanitised using an antiviral solution.



Limousine use guidelines:

- Passengers in the rear of the vehicle should be from the same household. If not, all passengers should wear face coverings and gloves, which we can supply.
- Passengers will not be permitted to travel in the front passenger seat.
- Passengers are asked not to open the doors themselves, but to wait for the driver to open the doors for them.
- Your driver is required to maintain a social distance of 2 metres from the passengers in the limousine. Unfortunately, this means that our drivers will be unable to assist passengers into or out of the vehicle, or assist with seat belts, wheelchairs or child seats.
- We regret that we are currently unable to carry items such as wheelchairs or walkers in the boot of the limousine. Please make separate arrangements to transport such items to and from the funeral.
